

ADMISSIONS

In our admissions and selection procedures, we evaluate candidates based on a combination of their experiences, qualities, academic achievements, and the potential they bring to the learning, practice, and teaching environments. By adopting this comprehensive approach, we ensure that our admissions committee doesn't excessively emphasize any single factor and evaluates the applicant as a complete individual. The application has a non-refundable fee of \$100.00 USD.

DEGREE

An applicant to UAG School of Medicine must have the equivalent of 90 undergraduate semester credit hours to be considered for admission. While a bachelor's degree is highly recommended, it is not mandatory. Additionally, all premedical requirements must have been fulfilled at an accredited university or college in the United States or Canada.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

One year of General Biology with Lab
One year of Physics with Lab
One year of Organic Chemistry with Lab
One year of General or Inorganic Chemistry with Lab
One year of Mathematics (e.g. Calculus, Computer Science, or Statistics)
One year of English

*Puerto Rico applicants: If applying with 90 semester credit hours, you are subject to comply with JLDMPR requirements.

MCAT

The Medical College Admissions Test is required for all U.S. citizens and permanent residents applying to medical school.

DOCUMENTATION

The following documentation is needed to comply with the U.S. educational system and needed to verify the student's eligibility to register with the Mexican Department of Education. (All documents must be valid at the time of enrollment).

Candidates will receive an email invitation from the admissions office to schedule an interview. The interview fee is \$1,000.00 USD and must be paid prior to the interview. Candidates will have one month after the interview to fulfill the secondary documentation.
